



## Making a Will

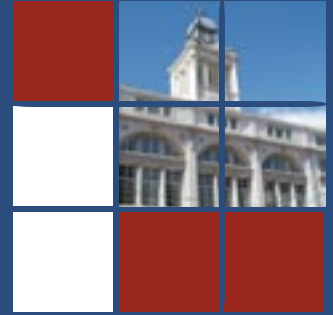
